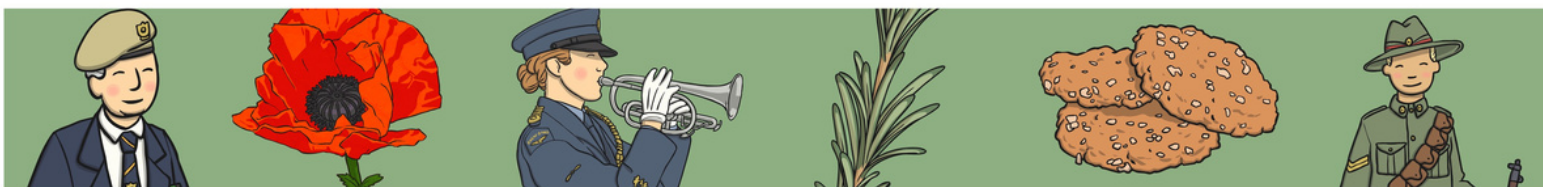
Dear Parents,

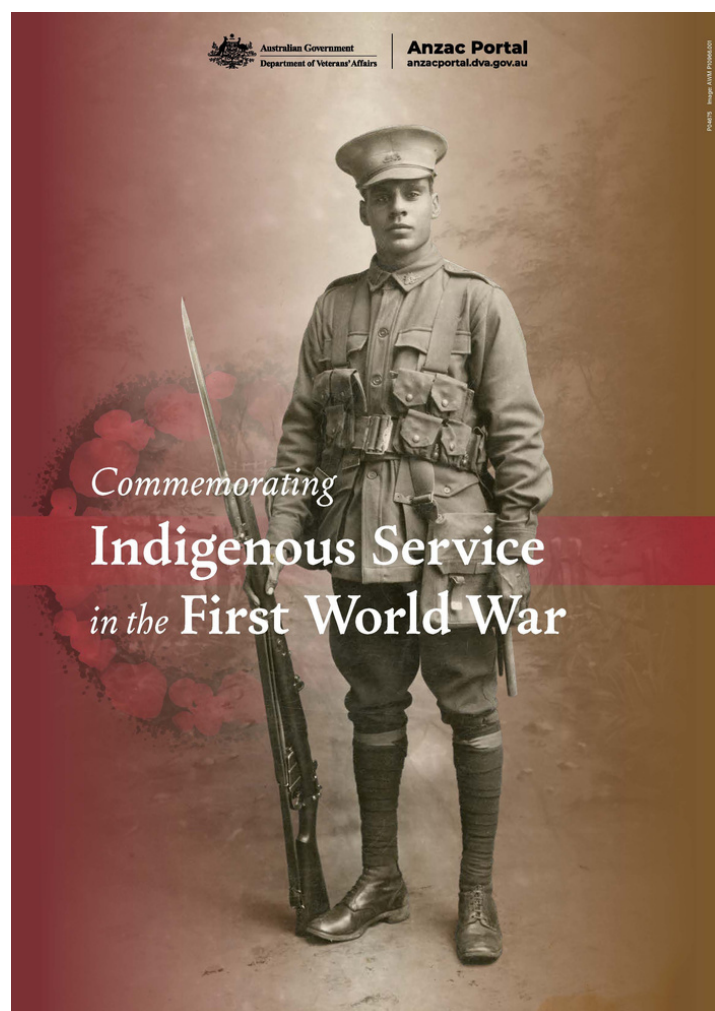
ANZAC DAY 2024
