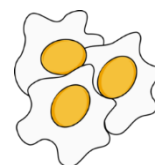

The Dental Contact Centre is open from 8.30am – 4.45pm on normal business days. You will need to give **Medicare Card** details for each child when you ring.

When receiving treatment parents will be encouraged to consent to Western NSW Local Health District claiming any available Medicare rebates from the Child Dental Benefits Schedule. These funds are used to provide additional dental services within Western NSW, benefitting the whole community.
