Kinderstart students have shared their second Kinderstart day with Miss Williamson. Already they are familiar with school routines both in the classroom and on the playground.

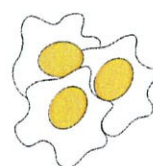

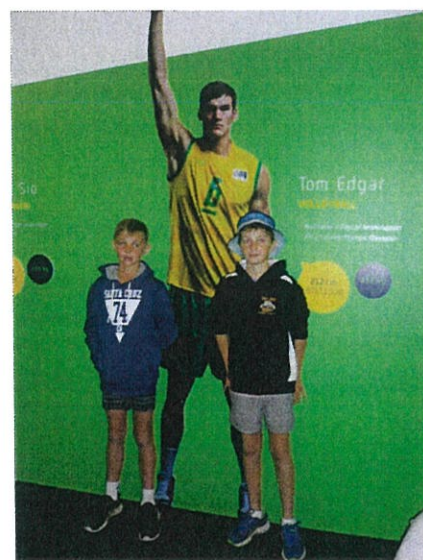
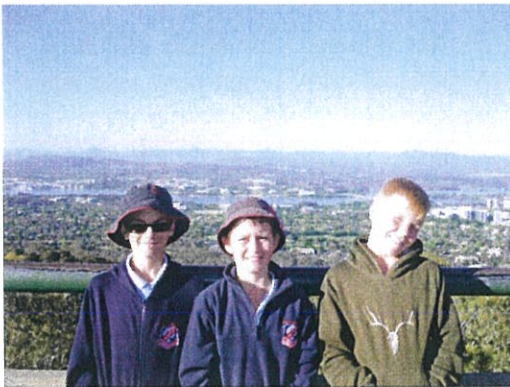

## Year 6 GO Glow DISCO

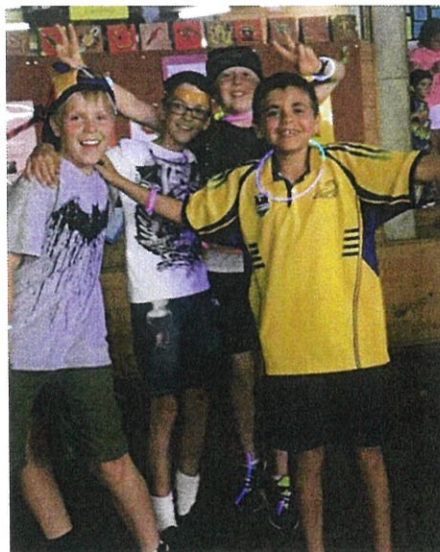
### **Year Six Fundraiser**

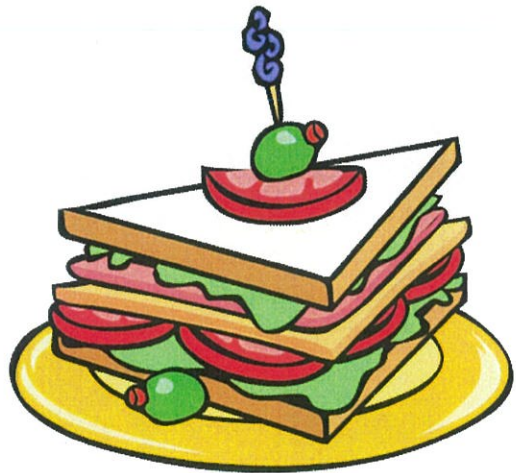
