Positive Behaviour for Learning (PBL) Focus

For the next two weeks our school PBL focus will be The Oval – Keep hands and feet to yourself. In this fortnight students will discuss the things we can and can't do with our hands and feet while using the oval. The lessons will follow "A day in the life of a hand" to outline the things our hands do in a day and when it is OK to do certain activities and when it is not.

Students will be questioned a lot about context. For example – is it OK to use your feet to kick? For this example it would be *right* to kick a ball, but *wrong* to kick another person. The students will be involved in activities to decide when and where it is right or wrong to do certain activities with our hands or feet.
