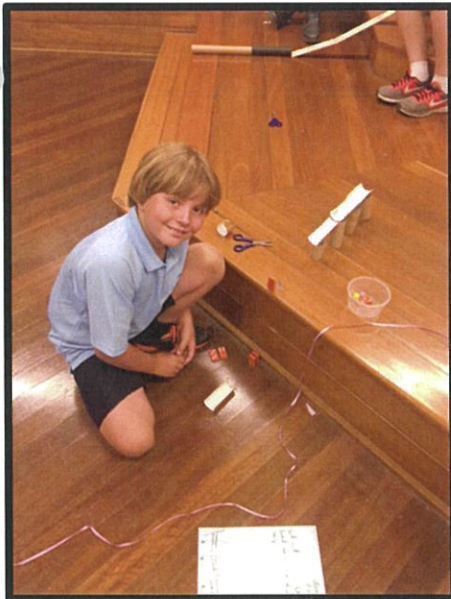
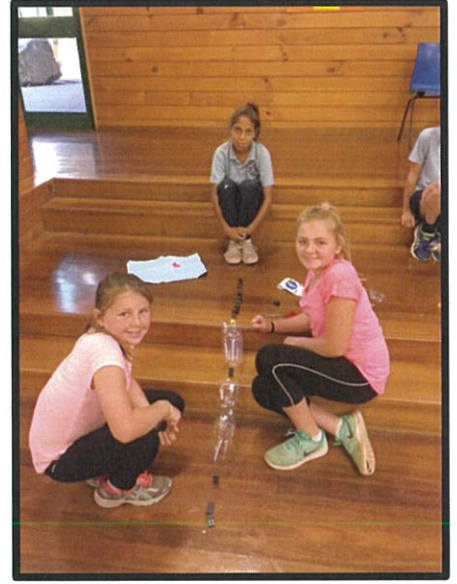
## Book Week

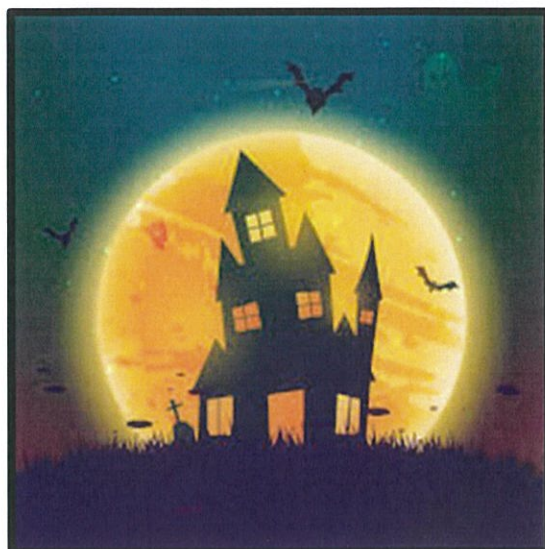

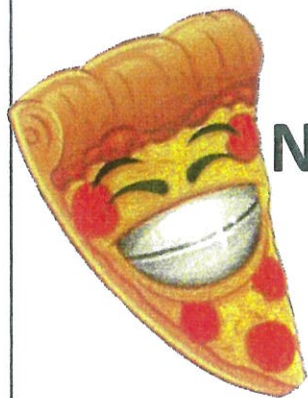

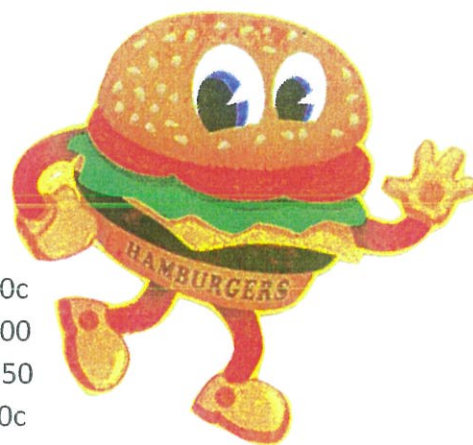
