Wheels are turning smoothly at Nyngan Public School kids Shed.

The Wellbeing team set up the shed project to provide a space for students to use hand tools, stay engaged in learning and meet with positive role models.

The shed is located beside the basketball courts and will be open for stage 3 students in the first week of Term 3. If parents are interested they can drop in Tuesdays and Thursdays during lunch.

The kids Shed is by invitation and part of the reward for good classroom behaviour. 6 Shed tickets will be handed out by classroom teachers. These tickets are presented to the teacher supervising the Shed during lunch.

This project allows students to engage in project based learning in a safe and secure environment. The Shed will move in 3 stages;

- Working on bikes, including tyres, chains, frames and general maintenance.
- Working on small 2 and 4 stroke engines, including lawn mower and wiper sniper engines.
- Working on school based projects, including repairing tables and benches.

Nyngan Public School is asking all families to help support this initiative by donating any old bikes, small engines or old tools to the shed project. Please be aware that we require old functional bikes that can be worked on and restored by our students.


