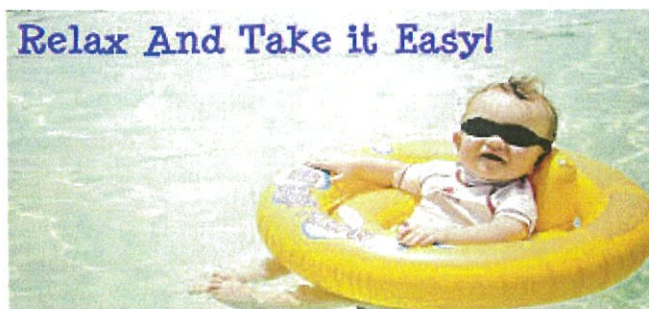

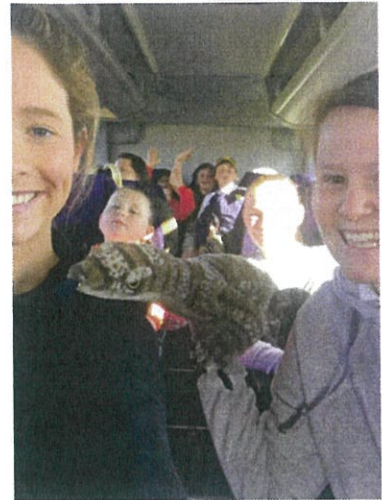
We would like to wish all our students and their families a very safe and happy holiday. We will see you all on Monday 9th October 2017.

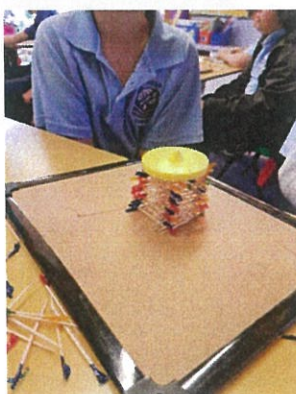
Year 3/4

The following pictures are the winners of the raft building.**



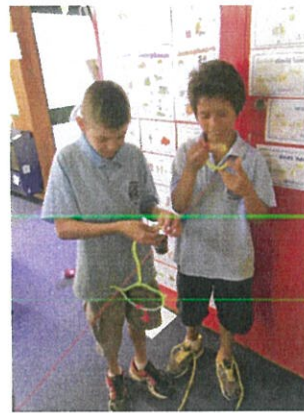
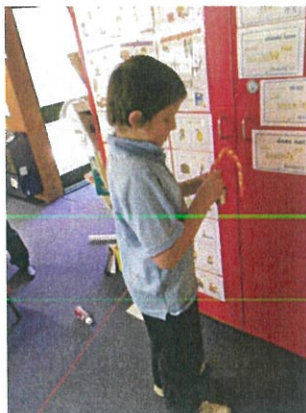
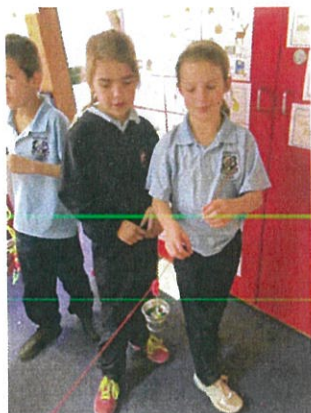
Build a toothpick tower that is at least 20 cm high. It must hold 20 grams of weight.
