Dear Parents/Carers,

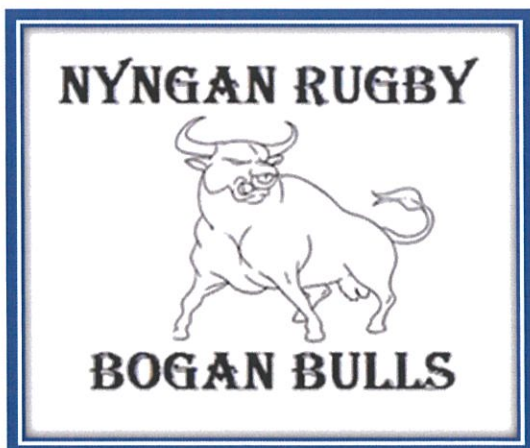
This week was SASS (School Administrative & Support Staff) week. I would like to thank all the SASS team for their dedication and effort they put into helping our staff and students.
